Experience Social Fun Through Semi-Structured “Hangouts/Meetups” by United Through H.O.P.E.

**Who’s Invited:** any individual going into in 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> (have not yet stopped attending high school, could be in the extended vocational aspects at a local public school). Signup is ongoing and fees are pro-rated for those that start AFTER the first date, but NOT for missing any dates once they start.

### ***General Overview of the events/outings (although may vary by event/outing)***

- ❖ Each outing is meant to promote socialization at common eateries, navigating paying, tipping, and preplanning, social chit chat, and social etiquette at eating establishments when out with peers. It also simulates the school lunch time, hallway, before/after school social chat, eat, and typical “hanging out” to build self-esteem, self-confidence, accountability, responsibility, and understanding through unstructured social opportunities.
- ❖ **At each meet up the group will meet first at the Denton site and then walk to and from the local eatery.**
- ❖ Special needs can be accommodated, and all events are supervised and guided by trained staff
- ❖ The enrollment fee does not include the funds to buy food, therefore, allowing our teens an opportunity to engage in a monetary planning session with their parents to prepare for the actual outing and bring the agreed upon funds to cover their meal and tip.
- ❖ If needing to eat Gluten free or accommodate for allergies these events offer an opportunity for the teens to contact the restaurant and learn how to navigate that aspect of their lives.

### **Cost for normal session:**

- **Program Total Cost is \$60 due if starting at first event** (does not cover the food at the restaurant-that is planned between parent and member prior to outing and brought to the meetup, only covers supervision)
- **If STARTING after first event** the enrollment fee will be pro-rated a certain amount based on the outings missed and an email will be provided with the pro-rated cost.
- No pro-rated costs if you miss an event once you start because you are out of town or sick.
- \$20 mandatory Intake for new members:
  - Intake must be completed by the Sunday evening one week before the closest event

- \$10 additional for each event they need transportation. Pickup and drop off times vary based on event heading to and from. Email is sent each week with that particular schedule. Pick up & drop off is from one of our site locations, but check actual enrollment form to confirm if and where there is transportation available.

**All members receive after enrollment:** The pictures of all members and an email before each event with details about what to expect and prep for.
