

The Summer 2020 Experience! FUTURE ALLSTARS for K-12th

Due to the intensity of this camp, this camp is only for individuals who have participated in any UTH program now or in the past. If a new member with UTH please see our other summer programs. Enrollment packets are only accepted between 2/1 and 4/1 and until spots are full.

Who's Invited: any child who is enrolling into grades 3rd-12th AND have been enrolled in any of our programs previously (LOF, Allstars, Future Allstars, Teen programs, holiday break programs, etc.). Only 40 slots per session available.

When: 2 sessions, Tuesdays and Thursdays with each day from 9:30-4pm:

Session 1: 6/2, 6/4, 6/9, 6/11, 6/16, 6/18, 6/23, 6/25

Session 2: 7/7, 7/9, 7/14, 7/16, 7/21, 7/23, 7/28, 7/30

Snapshot of Future Allstars:

- ❖ Various off campus activities, with one per week for all campers (on Thursdays), and Teens have one each day. Only entry costs are included in final cost of program. Outings range from parks, restaurants, swimming, shopping, to kid friendly trampoline parks, bowling, and rock climbing opportunities. Outings vary by age grouping.
- ❖ Lunch is provided by each camper each day unless off campus activity includes it.
- ❖ Each day of group the particular leadership lesson is integrated throughout the whole day. Throughout the entire Future Allstars an INTENSIVE emphasis is placed on social interaction, communication, cooperation, and shared ideas.

Snapshot of 3rd-5th program

- Designed for those who are entering 3rd-5th for the 2020-2021 school year, with an emphasis on cooperative play and sharing ideas and respect of others.
- On Tuesdays prep and complete the cooperative group activities (board games, stations, theme building activities, etc), Allstars store, 3 freetimes (including a "recess simulation"), and lunch on campus.
- On Thursdays discuss leadership lesson, 1 freetime, lunch location depends on off campus activity, and off campus outing.

Snapshot of Teen program (6th-12th):

- Designed for Teens entering grades 6th-12th for the 2020-2021 school year.
- This group is designed to help them work further on the insight needed to initiate, assist, problem solve, and work as a team. They will reflect on their skills and needs.
- On both days discuss leadership lesson, assist with setting up camp materials as needed for their group, plan/prep their end of session party, lunch is with the off campus outing for the day.
- On Tuesdays Teens have a campus outing that the younger K-5th does not participate in. Additionally, they will have the Allstars store and a teen oriented free time.
- On Thursdays teens discuss leadership lesson, 1 freetime, lunch location depends on off campus activity, and off campus outing.

“Home Base” Location:

- United Through H.O.P.E., Inc., 503 Bolivar, Denton, TX 76201 with transportation from our Frisco site available at an additional cost.

Cost:

- **3rd-5th \$325 PER session** (includes entrance fees associated with an outing but not any fees needed to shop, buy candy, sodas, etc.) due by May 1, 2020
- **6th-12th \$400 per session** (includes entrance fees associated with an outing but not any fees needed to shop, buy candy, sodas, etc.) due by May 1, 2020
- \$10 for mandatory camp t-shirt
- Transportation available from Frisco location \$10 roundtrip per day (pickup is 8am and drop off is 5:45pm)
- Daycare available \$5 per day at Denton location (daycare is from 8-9:15am & 4:15-5pm).

- **Open Enrollment for the program is from February 1, 2020 to April 1, 2020, all participants will need to complete the enrollment forms to be considered. No enrollments are accepted past this date and no enrollments are accepted once the slots are full for a particular session.**
- The 40 slots available each session are for no particular age or grade; therefore, as enrollment packets are received the groups may be tailored more specifically to who enrolls. Once the 40 slots are secured the session is considered full. There is NO wait list.
